ENERGY COMMUNITIES RECOMMENDATIONS

GROUP 1

- Reduce paperwork for small owners
 - Guaranteed green tariff has to be paid (as agreed)
 - Reduce paperwork for small owners
 - Tax reduction (to be defined)
 - Protection of energy community investors so they do not have debt in the end
- Group 3:
Information and advice for citizens to make energy communities
- Allow energy communities in cities
 - Do not require that energy communities must cover at least x%, as 70%
 - Freedom to sell electricity to members for a small fee
 - Bureaucracy has to be simple
 - Energy communities (smaller) do not need to have balancing responsibility
 - Abolish blocking regulations for windpower
 - Preference for energy communities for allowing wind and large solar plants

ENERGY COMMUNITIES RECOMMENDATIONS

GROUP 2

- Qualifying migrant workforce on energy topics
- Inform local authorities to get them involved in energy communities, using EU funding etc.
- One legal framework for energy communities in all countries
- Find localities willing to start energy communities where they energy communities do not exist
- Use local municipalities twinning to get more local authorities involved

ENERGY COMMUNITIES RECOMMENDATIONS

GROUP 3

- Information and advice for citizens to make energy communities
- Allow energy communities in cities

ENERGY COMMUNITIES RECOMMENDATIONS

GROUP 4

- Platform with information to share between energy communities, to make it easier for new initiatives
- Free advice for government on how to establish energy communities, free technical advice
- Freedom to choose different legal forms
- Need to identify needs, consumers can only buy shares compared to energy demand
- Maximise level of self-consumption
- Freedom to sell and donate excess production to anybody
- Easy access to funding, loans
- Priority to small and medium scale producers over bigger ones to enter the grid.
- Stable legislation
- Site dedicated to energy community projects.
- Fair management in the energy community
- Simple bureaucracy to allow energy communities, one-stop-show
- Platform for online production and consumption inside community
- Showcasing energy communities by local authorities
