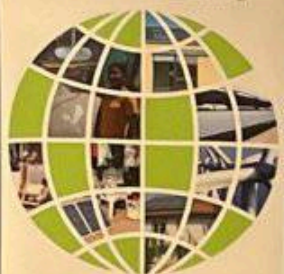


EVD projects contributing to 14 SDGs out of 17
